Ettington Pre-school (EPS) opening hours are in line with the County school term. Details of our Holiday Club fees are provided. EPS Holiday Club is invoiced separately.

EPS will be closed to children during Christmas week and the last two weeks of August for Maintenance.

Fee Structure – What Government Funding Covers and Additional Wrap Around Care:

Government funding is intended to deliver 15 or up to 30 hours a week of free, high quality, flexible childcare. Funding is paid for 38 weeks of the school year, term time only. Please see *EPS Terms and Conditions* on our website.

At EPS – There are a limited number of places for Eligible 2-year-olds who are able to access 15 hours per week on a term time basis (38 weeks a year). EPS does not provide funded places for 2-year-olds for up to 30hrs per week. Parents wishing to purchase additional sessions/hours are welcome to do so. Additional sessions/hours for 2-year-olds are charged in line with standard EPS fees and are subject to availability.

At EPS government funded childcare sessions are provided in 3 ways up to a strict maximum of 15hrs per week **Morning Sessions; Afternoon Sessions; Or Full days.**

(A very limited number of government funded places up to 30hr per week are available for children aged 3-4 yrs (Buttercups only) attending 4 days a week based on a criteria outlined in the *EPS Funding Policy* and are at EPS discretion.)

At EPS we do our best to fulfill childcare requirements for working parents by offering them the opportunity to book additional non-funded sessions and additional wrap around care. These additional hours are discretionary, so please discuss your needs with the EPS Manager at your earliest convenience, so that we can manage expectations and tailor your child's timetable.

EPS Timetable of Funded and Non-funded Hours:

The following timetables show EPS government funded hours and the cost of additional non-funded wrap round care. This is additional care that parents can add to the government funded sessions and are subject to availability. Government funded hours show a '0' charge. All hours and charges are itemized on invoices.

Food: 2 x snacks provided by EPS. Parents provide a packed lunch in line with government nutrition guidelines provided as part of the registration pack.
(There are no additional wrap around care options)

Administration and Place Holding Fees:

Once a child's place is agreed a non-refundable administration fee of £50.00 will apply in relation to hours/sessions booked in addition to funded hours. Many parents are applying for a place at the EPS well in advance, as places are limited. A 'Holding Fee' of £150 will be required to keep the place available and will be taken off your first invoice once your child starts. If the start date is postponed or the sessions are reduced, the 'Holding Fee' is non-refundable. 'Holding Fee' will not be required if you are booking a fully funded place with no additions. Please see the *Fee Structure* section of this document.

Once the Holding Fee is paid, the parents/carers are responsible for contacting the Pre-school to reconfirm their child place every 3 months until they start. Children are expected to start on the date they are booked for. If this is not reconfirmed then the place will be allocated to another child.

A Registration or Holding Fee will not be required if you are booking a fully funded place only for 15hr or up to 30hrs.

Invoicing:

Fees are invoiced termly and we would be grateful if you could pay as soon as possible, but full payment must be received a week before the end of term. If your child receives funding this will be taken off the cost of the invoice before it is sent to you and funded hours are displayed on the invoice as '0'. All expenditure is itemised.

Holiday Club will be invoiced separately.

Please talk to the Preschool Manager or the Administrator, if you are having difficulty paying or need to pay differently.
